

## A new look for the NCC 2022 Public Comment Draft

As part of the ABCB's commitment to delivering a National Construction Code (NCC) that is user-friendly and modern, we've made some changes to the NCC 2022 Public Comment Draft (PCD) process, to improve your experience commenting on the code's draft content.



## Round 1

All NCC content except energy efficiency and condensation

Due to the significant volume of proposed changes in NCC 2022, comment will be sought via 2 separate consultation processes to reduce the burden on stakeholders. The first round of consultation opens on **Monday 10 May**, seeking comment on all NCC content except energy efficiency and condensation.



## Round 2

Proposed content relating to energy efficiency and condensation

Proposed content relating to energy efficiency and condensation will then open for comment on **Monday 19 July**.
